

RECURENT PNEUMOCOCCUS MENINGITIS (COMMENTS CONCERNING A CLINICAL CASE)

We are presenting a case of post-traumatic recurrent pneumococcus meningitis which has totalized two recurrences in four years so far and succeeded a serious cranial traumatism which we suppose it led to an anterior fistula with intermittent right rhino liquoreea. We have considered the place and the characteristics of the injury facilitating the recurrences, the therapeutical attitude and the expected prophylactic measures.
