

ACTUAL ASPECTS OF THE CASES OF ACUTE DIARRHEA HOSPITALISED IN THE INFECTIOUS DISEASES DEPARTMENT OF TIMIȘOARA

The acute infectious diarrhea is an important problem of public health even in the countries with high sanitary standard. It continues to be a major

cause of morbidity and even mortality (at some groups with high risk) in the west part of our country. In this work are studied the patients hospitalized with acute infectious enterocolitis in the Clinics of Infectious Diseases in Dr.V.Babeş Hospital of Timișoara in the period 1990-1995. The faecal specimens were cultured on: ADCL, broth with selenit and Istrate Meitert. The examination of the results obtained allows the following observations: a) the number of patients hospitalized with the diagnosis of acute enterocolitis increased significantly; b) the number of cases with etiological diagnosis increased; c) the distribution of the cases on seasons changed; d) the chemiosensitivity of the identified germs has changed - especially Salmonella and Shigella; e) the change of the therapeutic schemes.
