

ELEMENTS OF PATHOMORPHOSIS IN PRESENT - DAY TRICHINELLOSIS (COMPARATIVE STUDY WITH THE CASES FROM THE LAST TWENTY YEARS)

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We have studied a number of forty-five patients with trichinellosis who were hospitalized in Arad during 1993-1994 and we have compared them with dates since 1973 when 713 cases have been followed and investigated. We have considered the following topics: changes of the clinical forms and the evolution; the presence of cardiovascular and nervous system complications; the relation infecting dose clinical form; the proportion eosinophilia/muscle biopsy - clinical form; the efficiency of the ethiological treatment. The noticed differences compared to 1973 - with the stipulation of not being especially significant of this diseases in full evolution in the last 5 years.
